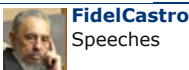

According to the website of the local Guerrillero newspaper, some of the titles include 'Imagine', 'Down by the Riverside', 'Step by Step', 'Do You Hear the People Sing?', and 'We Shall Overcome.' The Chorus also sings in Spanish 'La Guantanamera' and 'La Internacional.'

The New York City Labor Chorus, with 75 members representing over 20 labor unions and District Councils, was founded in 1991. It "promotes union solidarity by expressing through song the history and ongoing struggles of workers for economic and social justice."
